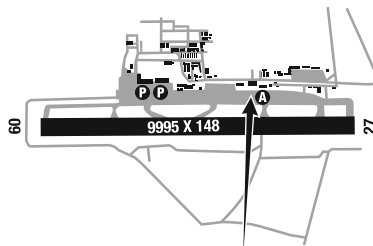

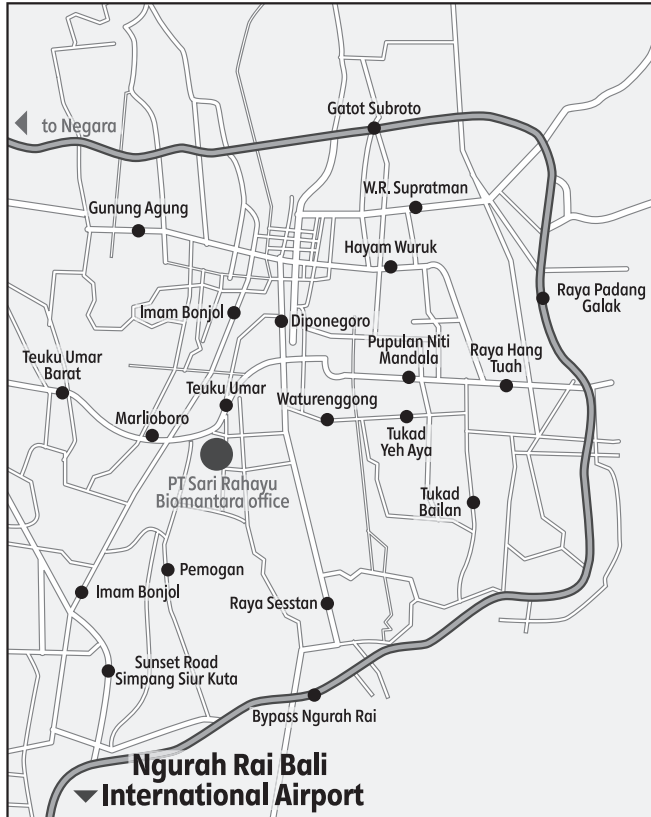

**Directions to airport**

Begin on Pulau Adi Street, then travel west on Teuku Umar Street. Turn South on Imam Bonjol Street. Turn left on Sunset Road Simpang Siur Kuta. Get on Ngurah Rai Street heading south and follow signs to the airport.

**Directions to office**

Head north on Ngurah Rai Street. Turn right on Sunset Road Simpang Siur Kuta and continue on before turning slightly right on Iman Bonjol Street. Turn east on Teuku Umar Street and exit Pulau Adi Street.
